### FORMAT / RULES

- ◆ Tournament is ACBL approved.
- ◆ ACBL rules will govern play.
- ◆ You do not need to be an ACBL member to participate unless you wish to receive Silver Masterpoints.
- ◆ ACBL memberships will be available for purchase at the on-site check-in desk at a cost of \$26 for a one-year membership.
- ◆ Format is Duplicate Bridge.
- ◆ There will be a Certified Tournament Director.
- ◆ All play is non-smoking, with breaks.
- ◆ Participants will be divided into divisions according to age.
- ◆ Partners' ages will be averaged to determine age division.
- ◆ If you do not have a partner, please indicate so on your registration form and we will attempt to find one for you.
- ◆ **Participants must play in all three sessions.** If a participant cannot attend a session due to conflict with another sport, he/she must contact the Director by 8:00 am. A substitute will be found for that session and the participant may return for subsequent sessions. Failure to notify the Director by 8:00 am will result in a permanent substitute replacing the participant for all remaining sessions with all awards going to the substitute.
- ◆ Country Club dress code applies – No jeans, tank-tops, short-shorts, etc.
- ◆ Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at the venue check-in desk between 9:00 and 9:30 am on the first day of play.

### MEDALS

- ◆ Highest Day 1 Scores in each division will be awarded Bronze medals.
- ◆ Three Highest 2-Day Cumulative Scores in each division will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.
- ◆ Highest Swiss Team Scores – Day 3 in each division will be awarded Gold Silver and Bronze medals.
- ◆ Medals will be awarded at the end of each session.
- ◆ The annual **Faye McCausland Award** will be presented at the Sport Sponsor Social for outstanding sportsmanship displayed during the tournament, embodying the true spirit of the Games. The recipient of this very special award will be selected through a vote by the Bridge players.

### FORMAT / RULES

- ◆ Tournament is sanctioned by USCF.
- ◆ USCF rated tournaments rules will govern play.
- ◆ All participants must be members of USCF.
- ◆ USCF memberships will be available for purchase at the on-site check-in desk. Annual memberships - \$36; single event membership - \$10.
- ◆ The tournament will be run by a Certified Tournament Director.
- ◆ All equipment will be provided by the St. George Chess Center, but participants are encouraged to bring their clock if they own one.
- ◆ Participants will be divided into divisions according to age.
- ◆ Each participant will play 5 rounds – 2 rounds on Friday and 3 rounds on Saturday.
- ◆ **Participants must play in all sessions.** If a participant cannot attend a session due to conflict with another sport, a ½-point bye is available if the participant notifies the Tournament Director at least two hours before their round.
- ◆ Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at the venue check-in desk between 11:30 am and 12:30 pm on the first day of play.
