

# GOLF SKILLS COMPETITION

## REGISTRATION RULES

- ◆ Only Medal Golf and Social Golf participants may participate in the Golf Skills Competition.
- ◆ Participants may register for one or all four events.
- ◆ Participants may register for each event only once until the day of the event.
- ◆ Participants wishing to register for additional attempts in any event, may do so on-site (the day of the event) - *time and space permitting* – for a fee of \$4 per attempt.

## FORMAT / RULES

- ◆ Soft spikes are required.
- ◆ Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at the venue check-in desk prior to their first event.
- ◆ In every event, participants making their first attempt will be allowed to compete before participants making repeat attempts.

## EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

### Long Distance Accuracy

Target Grid starts at 150 yards out and 70 yards wide and extends to 300 yards out, but narrows to 40 yards wide. Contestants get five shots. Their longest drive - *in the grid* - is measured and recorded. Longest drive (men and women) wins.

### Putting Skills

Course is six holes. Total low score wins. Ties will be broken by the low score on the longest hole, then second longest, etc. If ties are still not broken, there will be a “putt-off” at 5:45 pm.

### Pitching Skills

Five pins will be set-up at varying distances with three rings around each pin. Contestants will pitch to any pin. Points will be awarded each shot based on its distance from the pin. Most total points win. If tied, the highest single points on one shot will win.

### Chip & Run

From a distance of about 40 yards, contestants must chip & run to a pin located on the back of the green. Shots must land short of the green and “run to the pin”. Each contestant will be given four shots. The closest shot will be measured and recorded. Closest shot to the pin will win. Ties will be broken by the second closest shot of those tied.

## AWARDS

Awards will be presented to the top finishers in each event at the Sport Sponsor Social. In the Long Distance Accuracy event awards will be given to both men and women.

## REGISTRATION RULES

- ◆ The event is sanctioned by the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association (NHPA).
- ◆ NHPA membership is required for participation.
- ◆ Participants must include their NHPA Card Number and Ringer Percentage on their registration form.
- ◆ To receive an NHPA membership, contact the Horseshoe Director for information. You may purchase a membership at the Horseshoe Complex check-in table for \$12.00.
- ◆ If you have no ringer percentage, contact the Horseshoe Director. You will need to be at the Horseshoe venue by 8:30 am the first day of play to establish your percentage by pitching 100 shoes, counting ringers only. Once your ringer percentage is established, you will be entered in that division.
- ◆ Ringer Percentage Divisions: 70%+ = above 60.1%  
60% = 50.1 - 60.0 %  
50% = 40.1 - 50.0 %  
40% = 30.1 - 40.0 %  
30% = 20.1 - 30.0 %  
20% = 10.1 - 20.0 %  
10% = 1.1 - 10.0 %
- ◆ Since we are unable to adjust our schedules to accommodate multi-sport participants, *Horseshoe participants may not enter other sports scheduled from October 15 – 18.*

## FORMAT / RULES

- ◆ Men 50-69 will pitch 40 foot distance.
- ◆ Men 70+ and Women may pitch 30 foot distance.
- ◆ Ringer percentages and pitching distance are used to determine pitching divisions.
- ◆ Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at the venue check-in desk one-half hour before the start of their matches to check-in and assist with grooming pits.
