REGISTRATION RULES

- Participants must provide their Handicap Index (HI) and Card Number on their registration form.
- Changes in HI may be called into the HWSG office until Sept. 1. No changes in HI will be allowed after Sept. 1.
- Foursomes are determined by age and handicap.
- Requests for specific foursomes will not be accepted.
- Refer to Page 10 for a listing of area golf courses.
- Sign up for Golf Skills – See next page.

FORMAT / RULES

- All courses require soft spikes.
- Cart fees are included in the Sport Fee.
- All golfers must adhere to the local rules of the course at which they are playing. These rules could include “cart path only”, “90 degrees across all fairways” or other course specific rules.
- Only registered golfers are allowed on the course.
- Personal GPS or laser devices are allowed.
- Pace of play will be monitored during the tournament. Slow play will be warned and, if necessary, penalized.
- Course of play will be determined following the close of registration.
- Course of play and foursomes will be posted at the Dixie Center on October 5th.
- Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at their venue check-in desk between 7:15 am & 8:00 am each morning of play.
- 18 holes of golf will be played each day.
- This is a 36-Hole Gross and 36-Hole Net tournament.
- Each age bracket with more than 12 participating golfers will be separated into two divisions (A & B) based on Handicap Index. Handicap Index Divisions will be determined after the close of registration. The handicap cutoff for Division A and Division B will vary for each age bracket.

MEDALS

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to participants with the lowest gross and lowest net scores in each age and handicap division. Individuals may only win one award. Medals will be presented at the Sport Sponsor Social.

FORMAT / RULES

- All courses require soft spikes.
- Carts are included in Sport Fee.
- All golfers must adhere to the local rules of the course at which they are playing. These rules could include "cart path only", "90 degrees across all fairways" or other course specific rules.
- Only registered golfers are allowed on course – no caddies.
- Personal GPS or laser devices are allowed.
- 18 holes of golf will be played in each session.
- Best Ball Scramble format.
- All ages and handicaps will play together in an A-B-C-D format.
- Requested foursomes that do not meet the A-B-C-D criteria may not be eligible to win team prizes.
- Course of play will be determined by a blind draw.
- Course of play and foursomes will be posted at the Dixie Center on October 5th.
- Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at their venue check-in desk between 7:15 am and 8:00 am the morning of the event to guarantee tee time.

AWARDS

- Play is for prizes, no medals will be awarded.
- Only teams meeting the A-B-C-D criteria will qualify for team prizes.
- Prizes will be awarded at the Sport Sponsor Social.
- Participants must be present at the Sport Sponsor Social to win prizes.

REGISTRATION RULES

- Participants may register for one or all four events.
- Participants may register for each event only once until the day of the event.
- Participants wishing to register for additional attempts in any event, may do so on-site (the day of the event) - time and space permitting – for a fee of \$5 per attempt.

FORMAT / RULES

- Soft spikes are required.
- Participants must present their HWSG ID Badge at the venue check-in desk prior to their first event.
- In every event, participants making their first attempt will be allowed to compete before participants making repeat attempts.

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

Long Distance Accuracy (Men / Women and Age Divisions)

Target Grid starts at 150 yards out and 70 yards wide and extends to 300 yards out, but narrows to 40 yards wide. Contestants get five shots. Their longest drive - in the grid - is measured and recorded. Longest drive wins.

Putting Skills (Men and Women Divisions)

Course is nine holes. Total low score wins. Ties will be broken by the low score on the longest hole, then second longest, etc. If ties are still not broken, there will be a "putt-off" at 5:45 pm.

Pitching Skills (Men and Women Divisions)

Five pins will be set-up at varying distances with three rings around each pin. Contestants will pitch to any pin. Points will be awarded each shot based on its distance from the pin. Most total points win. If tied, the highest single points on one shot will win.

Chip & Run (Men and Women Divisions)

From a distance of about 40 yards, contestants must 'chip & run' their ball to a pin located on the back of the green. Shots must land short of the green and 'run to the pin'. Each contestant will be given four shots. The closest shot will be measured and recorded. Closest shot to the pin will win. Ties will be broken by the second closest shot of those tied.

MEDALS

Gold Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each event for each division. Medals will be awarded following competition.
